Jael was Hebar's wife. This put her in the exact right location when the general of the enemy army fled the battle. B. God prepared a treaty between Heber (Jael's husband) and Jabin. God had prepared many small details of this story to point to the fact that only He could orchestrate all of these events to work out according to His plan. He had been preparing people and situations for this very moment. We saw the same last week in the story of Ehud. Application Notes:
