

VERSES – Week #2

1. Who is the Holy Spirit?

- Answer: The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, co-equal with God the Father and God the Son.
- Scripture Reference: Matthew 28:19 – “Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost:”

2. Was the Holy Spirit present in creation?

- Answer: Yes, the Holy Spirit was present in the Creation of the world.
- Scripture Reference: Genesis 1:2, "And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.”

3. How does the Holy Spirit indwell believers?

- Answer: The Holy Spirit indwells believers when they accept Jesus Christ as their Savior. This indwelling empowers them to live a godly life.
- Scripture Reference: Ephesians 1:13 – “In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise”

4. What are the gifts of the Holy Spirit?

- Answer: The gifts of the Holy Spirit are spiritual abilities given to believers for the building up of the church.
- Scripture Reference: 1 Corinthians 12:7 – “But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.”

5. How does the Holy Spirit guide believers?

- Answer: The Holy Spirit guides believers through the truth of God’s Word.
- Scripture Reference: John 16:13, "When the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all truth."

6. What is the role of the Holy Spirit in sanctification?

- Answer: The Holy Spirit works to make believers more like Christ, a process called sanctification.
- Scripture Reference: 2 Corinthians 3:18, "And we, with unveiled faces, all reflect the Lord's glory, as a mirror reflects the brightness of the sun. We are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord who is the Spirit."

7. What qualities does the Holy Spirit seek to develop in the life of the believer?

- Answer: The Holy Spirit seeks to develop the fruits of the Spirit in the life of a believer.
- Scripture Reference: Galatians 5:22-23 – “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.”
